Registration is now open for Rock League 2026.

Rock League is a 3-on-3 youth boys basketball league designed to help young players develop their skills, learn how to play the game, compete, and have fun. The league promotes teamwork, simple concepts, and involvement from all players. In a 3-on-3 setting, every player has the opportunity to handle the ball, make decisions, and participate on offense.

There will be two leagues this year:

- 3rd/4th Grade
- 5th/6th Grade

Each league will be limited to 32 players (8 teams). Teams will consist of four players and a coach.

Individual Registration

Based on nearly unanimous feedback from last year, all players will register individually this season. Once registration is complete, players will be placed on teams, and we will do our best to create teams that are as evenly matched as possible. It is likely I will be reaching to a number of parents for input.

One of the best aspects of Rock League over the past decade has been the understanding among parents and players of what the league is about. Keeping the teams balanced helps us maintain those goals and gives players the opportunity to play with different teammates and take on different roles.

Coaches

Each team will need a coach, and coaches are encouraged to organize their own practices by finding a time and location that works for their team.

The registration form includes a place to indicate whether you are willing to coach or if you know someone who is willing. With individual registration, having enough parents and coaches is especially important. If you are interested in coaching but don't have much experience, please reach out. I would be happy to provide some guidance, structure, fundamentals, and concepts that work well at this age.

League Details

- Season: Five Sundays, October 18 – November 15
- Games: Sunday afternoons between 2:00–4:00 p.m.

- Location: Maroon Activities Center (MAC)
- Games: Each team will play two games each Sunday
- Game length: 25 minutes
- Officials: Montana Tech men's basketball players
- Cost: \$100 per player
- Registration deadline: October 7
- Registration: First come, first served

Each team will receive four team T-shirts, with each team having a different color. Players will keep their shirts and are welcome to add names or numbers to the backs if they choose.

The score will be kept during games. While the focus of Rock League is development and fun, competition is an important part of learning the game. We want kids to experience both winning and losing, learn how to compete, and learn how to respond to both.

“The Rock” 3 on 3 youth boys’ basketball league 2026

- Goals of the league: Teach all kids how to play using simple concepts where everyone develops offensive scoring skills. 3 on 3 basketball puts kids in a position where everyone should handle the ball and participate on offense. Focus should be on fundamentals, teamwork, and fun. The score will be kept. Teach kids how to deal with winning or losing a game.
- Two leagues – 3rd/4th grade; 5th/6th grade
- Teams will consist of 4 players and a coach. Players must register individually and will be placed on a team. We will do our best to split teams evenly.
- Each league will be limited to 8 teams. The deadline for entries is October 7.

- Games will be played on Sunday afternoons between 2pm & 4pm. Season runs for 5 Sundays between October 18 and November 15.
- Games will be played at the Maroon Activities Center (MAC) - 4 simultaneous games. Each team will play two games each Sunday. Game officials will be Montana Tech Mens Basketball Players.
- Games are limited to 25 minutes each.
- Cost is \$100 per individual.
- Coaches are encouraged to organize their own practices. Find their own location and time.
- Four T-shirts will be provided for each team. Each team will be a different color. The shirts will be for the players to keep. They can print names/numbers on the back if they want.
